Stall cost is \$15 payable on the day.

QPA members will be on site to direct stall holders to their relevant positions and provide any assistance you might need.

Please note that we are unable to offer powered sites for use by heating or cooking appliances – the hall has a small load capacity and this is used up by the hall's kitchen on the day.

Trading Conditions:

- · all commercial stallholders must hold appropriate insurance and comply with all relevant health regulations if selling food;
- a copy of your current market stallholder public liability insurance policy, and product liability where appropriate, needs to be shown to the QPA stall organiser;
- where possible, stallholders are to provide and erect their own tables, trestles, shade and wet weather cover;
- stall size is approximately 3m x 3m;
- all stalls must be set up and operational by 10:00am and all vehicles and trailers removed by 9:45am;
- · Stall holders are required to remain operating until 2pm
- no further vehicle access until 2pm at the earliest.
